

Ride-Well Series
IMPORTANT THINGS TO KNOW-RULES

- This is a SCHOOLING series designed to prepare riders for RATED/RECOGNIZED shows
- USEF rules for Dressage and Jumpers will apply except where indicated otherwise by *
- A copy of USEF rules will be available at the show.
- All exhibitors will receive a bridle number that will be used throughout the show series. If the number is lost, you will be required to purchase a new bridle number for \$3.00
- All Dressage tests will be done in a SHORT COURT (20m x 40m)
- All **INTRO** DRESSAGE TESTS (A, B, C) MAY BE COACHED*
- All JUMP ROUNDS UP TO 2' MAY BE COACHED* Jump rounds from 2'3 and up will not allow for coaching.
- A warm-up area will be provided for dressage and at least 1 jump in a separate area will be available for jumping warm-up
- 2 show rings will be utilized; one for dressage and one for jumping and will run concurrently
- The jumping ring will have a time window for each level (Groundrails: 10 - 10:30, Crossbar: 10:40 - 11:20, etc)
- Dressage tests will be grouped by level unless special requests are made for coaching, etc. Ex: All Intro A tests will go; then all Intro B tests, etc.
- Dressage scores will be made available as soon as all riders in the division have been judged and scored
- There will be 1 jump pattern. Riders may enter to jump a level a maximum of two times. **The first jump round will count toward placing.**
- There will only be jumper rounds; no hunter divisions. These rounds will be based on time and faults. Time penalties will be accrued over the optimum time at 1 penalty per each second over the time allowed.
- Faults will be scored with USEF Jumper rules:
 - Rail down = 4 faults
 - 1st refusal/runout = 4 faults
 - 2nd refusal/runout = 8 faults
 - 3rd refusal/runout = Elimination**A final fence may be allowed to give the horse a successful experience before leaving the ring.
- Jumper Only classes: Ribbons will be awarded for the least faults and closest to the optimum time; NOT THE FASTEST TIME. This is to encourage safety and horsemanship.
- We will have a jump crew that is responsible for set-up and re-set
- Ribbons will be awarded for 1st thru 4th place at the end of each division and a victory gallop will be offered **if deemed safe** in jump classes
- Series points will be accumulated in the following way:
 - 1st Place: 4 points
 - 2nd Place: 3 points
 - 3rd Place: 2 points
 - 4th Place: 1 points
- Series awards will be prizes and cash for Champion and Reserve of each Division
